Gas Lamps

These lamps (circa 1890) are from a fire engine based at the paper mill in Inverurie. When the paper mill was acquired by an American company, the engine was exported there.

These lamps are also fitted to the Halley fire engine. (As shown in the photograph). The lamps were presented by Mrs Margaret Ferris of Scone, Perthshire (daughter of the engineer in charge of the the Fire Engine, who restored the lamps.)
