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## Radial Branch

The radial branch was designed to facilitate the handling of very large jets, but is not widely used now. The one pictured on below is designed for use with nozzles up to 51mm (2inches) in diameter.

When working under high pressure with a large nozzle the radial branch requires considerable quantities of water and twin lines of hose are necessary to supply it.
